New law to make life better for all dogs

Sweeping new state government guidelines aim to protect pups

ETHICAL dog breeders like local enthusiast Ann Clarkson will have nothing to fear under new mandatory breeding guidelines aimed at raising welfare standards for dogs and puppies.

The German shepherd breeder has been producing dogs for 15 years and said breeders would always exceed minimum standards. "At home, my dogs and the puppies live in the bedroom until they go to their new homes," she said.

The new laws require owners to ensure bitches are physically mature and healthy before each litter, and for puppies to be properly weaned and socialised before re-homing.

RSPCA Queensland spokesperson Michael Hearty said the organisation hoped the laws would provide clarity for breeders, but added consumers should remain alert when looking to adopt a pet. "People who decide they want to get a puppy need to

make sure they never buy one without seeing how the mother and father live," he said. Breeders who fail to meet the standards face investigation and fines, with the current maximum penalty for an individual convicted of a breach of

duty of care set at \$39,055 or one year in prison. Minister for Agricultural Industry Development and Fisheries Mark Funnell said the new standards would ensure breeders were doing the right thing.

"The new laws recognise that breeding dogs have specific needs and require specialised care," he said. "They also set minimum standards for care, shelter, socialisation and breeding, and will apply to all dog breeders including those breeding pets, working dogs, hunting dogs or for commercial purposes."

Biosecurity Queensland spokesperson said the department had "partnered with Dogs Queensland and the RSPCA to undertake a wide-reaching public education campaign via media, social media, paid advertising and veterinary publications, including the AVA, to promote the new standards."



+ 8 premolars + 4 molars


In the lower jaw there are 22 teeth

6 lower incisors + 2 canines +
8 premolars + 6 molars

WHY IS IT CALLED A GERMAN SHEPHERD DOG?



The German Shepherd Dog is one of the few breeds whose official name actually includes the word “dog”. This is a bit weird – or is it? The word “dog” was added so people understood whether you were talking about a human German Shepherd (someone who tends the livestock), OR the dog helping him.



Do not ever feed the following substances as they are toxic to dogs (note this is not an exhaustive list): onions, onion powder, garlic, chocolate, coffee or caffeine products, mouldy or spoiled foods or compost, avocado, bread dough, yeast dough, grapes, raisins, sultanas (including in Christmas cakes etc), currants, nuts including macadamia nuts, fruit stones (pits) e.g. mango seeds, apricot stones, avocado stones; fruit seeds, corncobs; green unripe tomatoes, mushrooms; fish constantly, cooked bones; small pieces of raw bone, fatty trimmings/ fatty foods, Salt, Xylitol (sugar substitute found in some products such as some types of sugarfree chewing gum, lollies, baking goods, toothpaste and sugarfree peanut butter).

SUMMER HEAT REMINDERS



Take your dogs for their exercise early in the morning in summer, before the day gets too hot.

When you take your dog for a walk, it is not just the heat from above that can be a hazard — think about the ground under the dog's paws.

Take them to cooler areas. Walk them on the grass if you can.

Some dogs do not know when to stop, and this can be dangerous in the summer months.

If you're throwing a ball, you're not getting as hot as the dog who is chasing the ball constantly. Some of our young and active dogs, they're not going to think about stopping exercising when they should stop. They will keep running and running until they go into heatstroke.

Dogs that are catching balls in waves, they can also be taking in salt water which can make them vomit and also give them diarrhoea, and it can be lethal for them if they've taken in enough salt water.

Always ensure your four-legged (or feathered, or scaly!) friends have **fresh clean water** every day and lots of it! More than one dog has been known to simply upend the water dish in an attempt to cool down too, so you may also need to top it up regularly (or make it easy on yourself and buy a shell pool!).



NEVER LEAVE YOUR DOG IN THE CAR !!!



Not even for 30 seconds. Even on cloudy days, the temperature inside the car will increase very quickly — even with the window down or the air conditioning on.

Dogs in particular are at severe risk of heat exhaustion and death in this situation, so it's never worth the risk.
