

GSDCQ Club Point Score 2023 Rules

1. To be eligible, you must be a financial member of the GSDCQ in the year of the Point Score.
2. If a dog is partly owned by a QLD financial member and another state financial member, they are eligible to participate.
3. To be eligible the member exhibitor must exhibit at least one animal at a GSDCQ hosted show. This applies to the owner and not the dog exhibited. For example, Exhibitor A could have 5 dogs to exhibit. They only need to exhibit one dog at a GSDCQ hosted show to be eligible for all of their dogs to participate in the Point Score.
4. The Point Score will include all GSDCA Specialist Shows including Championship Shows, Members Comps and State Breed Shows as well as the GSDCQ Open Show. The shows must have GSDCA gradings.
5. The Point Score Year will commence from December to Working Dog Club in Victoria show.
6. Awards will be presented at the end of year GM along with other Awards.
7. If there is any dispute arising from the points calculation then the Management Committee will review and their decision will be considered final.
8. Point Score Awards being offered –

 - Puppy Dog Male SC Winner
 - Puppy Dog Female LSC Winner
 - Puppy Dog Male LSC Winner
 - Adult Dog Female SC Winner

 - Adult Dog Male LSC Winner
 - QLD Resident Overall Point Score Winner
 - Breeder of the Year
 - Stud Dog of the Year
 - Dam of the Year
 - Top Obedience Female
 - Top Obedience Male

 - Top Rally Male
9. Scoring System –
 - All Puppy awards can only have points allocated from 3 months to under 12 months
 - All Adult awards can have points allocated from 12 months onwards

When a puppy reaches 12 months old the accumulated points carry over to the adult pointscore.
